

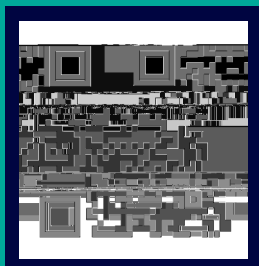
# What is a Masters with Advanced Practice?
